Biography

Hanna Na '08, violin, born in Seoul, South Korea began her training at the age of six. In 1997 she performed the Bruch Violin Concerto at the Hall of Arts in Korea, and in 1998 she performed the Mendelsshon Violin Concerto in Austria. Hanna attended Yaewon Arts School in South Korea before coming to the United States. She won the Young Performers competition in 1998 and received first place honors for the Paul Rudoff Scholarship offered by the Island Senior Symphony in 2000. In 2001 she received an honorary scholarship award at the Juilliard School Pre-College Division. The same year Hanna was selected as a finalist in the Pathways Women's Health Teen Music Competition. In addition, she has performed at the Juilliard Theatre and Paul Hall. She had a solo performance at the Weill Recital Hall at Carnegie Hall in 2003. Hanna also played in the Vivaldi youth ensemble under the director Hyo Kang who is also a director of the Sejong Soloists. The performance of the Vivaldi youth ensemble was broadcast on KBS Korea Channel. She played a solo concerto with the Bay Area Baffa Friends of the Fine Orchestra in April 2003. In the same year, she performed at Alice Tully Hall with the Lincoln Center Chamber Society.

After she came to Williams College in 2004, she won the Berkshire symphony soloists competition in 2005 and in 2007. For both years, she performed Tchaikovsky and Brahms violin concerto with the Berkshire Symphony. Hanna also performed solo with the Newborough Symphony in the winter of 2006. She had several solo recitals at Brooks-Rogers Hall and participated in chamber music. For her years at Williams she has served as an assistant concertmistress of the Berkshire Symphony. Hanna has studied with Dorothy Delay, Hyo Kang, Masao Kawasaki and Aaron Rosand, and is now studying with Joanna Kurkowicz at Williams College.
