His compositions have been premiered by campus groups such as the Berkshire Symphony, the Opus Zero Band and the Brass Ensemble, and he has produced concerts as part of the I/O New Music and Winterstock Art Festivals. Also active as a conductor, trumpeter, and pianist, Jacob conducted the Williams Student Symphony in performances of Stravinsky's *Dumbarton Oaks Concerto* and Reich's *Triple Quartet*, and will be attending the Bang on a Can Summer Music Festival in July. Next year Jacob will be studying for a Master's in Music Composition at the
