## Biography Shai Vosner

Pianist Shai Vosner has attracted international recognition for his exceptional artistry, musical integrity and creative insight. His performances of a broad range of repertoire from Beethoven and Mozart to Schoenberg and Ligeti, as well as music by his contemporaries, communicates his imaginative programming and intellectual curiosity.

Mr. Vosner has appeared with numerous major orchestras in North America including the Chicago Symphony, Los Angeles Philharmonic, the National Arts Centre Orchestra, the St. Paul Chamber Orchestra, and the symphony orchestras of Atlanta, Baltimore, Berkeley, Cleveland, Dallas, Indianapolis, Milwaukee, Philadelphia, Pittsburgh and San Francisco. He has worked with such conductors as Daniel Barenboim, Jiří Bělohlávek, James Conlon, Alan Gilbert, Gunther Herbig, James Judd, Zubin Mehta, Peter Oundjian, Donald Runnicles, and Leonard Slatkin.

This season, Mr. Vosner's orchestral engagements include Mozart piano concertos with the Hamburger Symphoniker conducted by Jeffrey Tate, the BBC Scottish Symphony led by Andrew Manze, and the Discovery Ensemble led by Courtney Lewis at Boston's Jordan Hall. He will also play the German premiere of Michael Hersch's concerto "Along the Ravines" (a work he commissioned and premiered with the Seattle Symphony in 2012) with the Deutsche Radio Philharmonie-Saarbrücken.

Mr. Vosner has been widely praised for his interpretations of Schubert's solo works, both in concert and in recording. Of his most recent solo recording, released by Onyx in October 2011, *Gramophone* magazine wrote, "With this recital Shai Vosner declares himself a Schubertian of unfaltering authority and character."

Mr. Vosner lives in New York City.
