

Artist Bios

Susan Cheng, founder and Executive Director of Music From China, performs on ruan, and is a concert lecturer and narrator.

Wang Guowei is erhu soloist, composer, and Artistic Director of Music From China. He studied at the Shanghai Conservatory and was former concertmaster and erhu soloist of the Shanghai Traditional Orchestra. With an active solo career, Wang Guowei has performed with artists and groups including the Amelia Piano Trio, 3rd Angle New Music Ensemble, Continuum, DaCamera of Houston, Post Classical Ensemble, Virginia Symphony, Brooklyn Philharmonic, Ethos Percussion Group, Ornette Coleman, Butch Morris, Kenny Garrett, Shanghai String Quartet, and the 2012 Spoleto Festival and Lincoln Center Festival.

Wang Junling inherits the Henan style of zheng music from her family. She graduated from Henan University and was soloist with the Henan Song and Dance Drama Academy.

Sun Li graduated from the Shenyang Music Conservatory where she studied pipa. She was a member of the Central Song and Dance Ensemble in Beijing.

Helen Yee performs on yangqin and is an active free jazz violinist performing with various artists.
